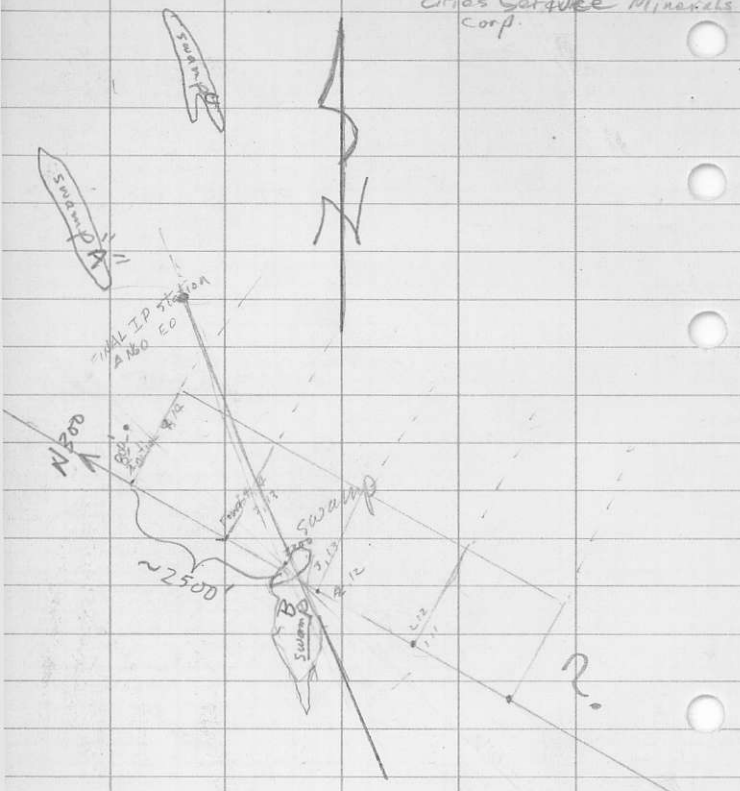

some have weathered py xls. (very few)
Abundant Hematite stain
- apparently py has oxidized to Hem.
but some looks like primary
Hematite.

Flow structures appear to be horiz
striking ~ 270°

Each flow appears to differ slightly
from others.

The predominate Rhyolite Type

- ¹⁵ SA# ① - Light in colour, ^{white} brownish, with a minor
73-5-5-27 Light Hematite stain, There is
usually very trace amounts of
pyrite, cubic xln Py

An other common variety is exemplified by:

- SA# ②
73-5-5-27 This Rx has a spotted-speckled
appearance due to Hematite
blobs.
it is a light green in colour.
