We enclose a copy of the assay results received from samples taken from your pits during my visit of October 4th.


Before submitting these samples for assay, we had washed the rock fragments as a precaution against having any placer gold adhere to them, possibly resulting in an erratic high assay.

Thank you for a very pleasant and informative visit.

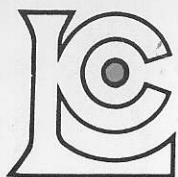
