## PROGRESS REPORT on the BEATON GROUP

This group of mineral claims represents 44 units in the Kamloops Mining Division, located northwest of Afton Mine (now held by D.R.C. Resources).

The Beaton #1 claim (20 units) is 100% owned by Lakewood Mining Co. Ltd.

The Beaton #2 claim (20 units), and the Snow 1 to 4 claims, represents 24 units, owned 100% by Green Valley Mine Incorporated.

A Multisensor Spectrometric Airborne Survey carried over the Iron Mask Batholith has outlined a very large Thorium, Potassium Ratio Anomaly in the northwest direction, paralleling the western flank of the Iron Mask Batholith. The anomaly is at least 1500 metres in length and is partly on the Beaton #1 claim and partly on he Beaton #2 claim.

The center of the geophysical anomaly is on the west side of ICE LAKE, and is known as the ICE LAKE ZONE.

An initial soil sampling survey carried out across the anomaly has indicated a very positive zone or zones of mineralization for a minimum of 1000 matres in the northeast direction. The results show high values for Copper, Nickel, Cobalt, Gold, Silver, and Palladium. One line returned continuous palladium values for 1000 metres.

The soil sampling survey is located approximately in the center of the geophysical anomaly and covers 1000 metres in the northwest direction, with five survey lines at 250 metre intervals in the northeast direction.

All the samples were taken at 50 metre intervals, and assayed by Xral Laboratories in Dons Mills, Ontario, with the Mobile Metal Ion technology. The geochemical, and geophysical results have been evaluated and interpreted by two independent consultants, and six diamond drill holes have been recommended.

## Conclusion: "Quote from the Geophysical Report"

"Patterns resulting from a multisenson airborne geophysical survey in the area surrounding the Beaton Claims bave been shown to provide direct vectoring to known, intrusion-related, economic mineralization. Similar patterns are evident within the Beaton Claim area.

The Company intends to carry out the diamond drilling recommendations as soon as the weather permits.
