Dear Paul:

In recent news releases and conversations with John Kerr, I noted the success of your 1984 drilling program on Frasersgold. I understand that additional sulphides were encountered in drilling this year, and I would like to repeat my request for a specimen or specimens of galena or sphalerite for isotopic analysis. I have enclosed a copy of the data sheet submitted to Randy Parrish, our geochronologist in Ottawa, pertaining to the syenite submitted for zircon-Pb dating. No results have been received yet.

John Kerr told me of his views on the similarity of the Frasersgold deposit to the Muruntau deposit in Usbek, S.S.R. I have requested copies of translated references, if available, from Ottawa, which I would be glad to pass along if you are interested.

I understand that an unidentified silver-white mineral is associated with gold and other metallic minerals at Frasersgold. I would be interested in examining it and identifying it, if material is available for study.
