Dear Dr. Dawson:

As we discussed on the phone yesterday, I am enclosing with this letter a copy of Gary Vivian's paper on Blackdome. It is primarily concerned with the fluid inclusion studies that he did in the course of his thesis work. To date, he has completed petrographic and geochemical studies of the ore and wall-rocks, electron microprobe analyses of the ore, and X-ray diffraction studies of clay minerals in the ore. It is my understanding that his thesis will be concerned with describing the general geologic setting, ore mineralogy, and wall-rock alteration and, ultimately, provide some insight regarding the genesis of the deposit. This work would, obviously, be of interest to both yourself and Dr. Christie (sp.?).
