Dear Ken:

Thank you for your letter of March 24 concerning your desire to conduct a study of the MIDWAY deposit during the coming field season.

As you are aware this property is in the preliminary stage of exploration and therefore our understanding of the host lithologies and deposit mineralogy are very general.

In our opinion we are not at a stage where significant comparisons can be made with other Devono-Mississippian deposits. We are very actively engaged in exploration in the area and until this is completed, and our property position finalized, our information must remain confidential.

Upper Sylvester volcanic rocks are much better exposed to the south of the Midway property and you would find good sections and contact zones to study near Cassiar.

Mr. D.G. MacIntyre of the B.C. Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources has proposed to spend time at MIDWAY this summer collecting samples for lithogeochemistry study and conodont extractions. Please contact him concerning this information.

Galena samples have been supplied to Dr. Colin Godwin at the University of British Columbia for Pb isotopic analyses.

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
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Hopefully our current exploration will be successful to a point that the MIDWAY property could aid you with your studies in 1983.
