mapped as metamorphic, actually a graben  
with thick felsic volcanics - now felsic, pyritic  
schist. Yellow gossan, unsampled.

150m of pyritic volcanics, felsic. massive sulphides.

Best mineral in boulders:

avg 18 boulders:

.056 Au      3.36 oz/t Ag      .17% Cu; 5.1% Pb; 6.9% Zn

Zn higher than Tulsequah.

Highest Au 0.1805/t. Always Cu + Pb + Zn up to 20%
