*An Update of the Sulphurets Property.*

The Sulphurets precious metal deposits, under exploration and development by the Sulphurets Joint Venture (Newhawk Gold Mines Ltd., 60%, and operator, Granduc Mines Ltd., 40%) are located 65 km northwest of Stewart in northwestern British Columbia. This area, within the Stikine Arch, also includes the Eskay Creek and Kerr deposits, the Snip Mine, and numerous other projects.

Since 1985, work at Sulphurets has been concentrated on the West Zone with over 50 000 m of diamond drilling (surface and underground) and 5000 m of underground development completed to date.

In October 1990, the results of a feasibility study on the West Zone were published. This paper will discuss the results of the feasibility study and some unique northern aspects of the transition from exploration to production.
