OLALLA GOLD CAMP HISTORY

First discovery: 1880's, Gold, Siver, Copper, Molybdenum

Early discoveries: Great Eastern, Shepard-Sunrise, Bullion, Dolphin, Golconda, Something Good, Olalla 1940's: Hedley - Monarch Mines shipped 300 tons yielding 0.53 oz Au from Shepard Sunrise workings

1960's: Friday Mines locates 3100 tons averaging 0.84 oz Au on Sweetner Vein, drilling at Shepard-Sunrise intersects 8 feet of 0.33 oz Au per ton

1970's: Trent Resources construct 100 tpd mill to process Golconda Cu-Mo ore

1980's: Freedom Resources drills Valley zone locating 15 ft of 0.03 oz per ton Au and 0.09 oz. per ton Ag
