2 mm. horizons lower: barite, regional extent
of lamellar spotty bent horizon, locally 1-2 m -
soon of CIRQUE bent - Pb-2m horizon - mixed under
Kechika thrust sheet overriding from west. Relictal,
very fossilized, poorly mineralized sulphides.

upper horizon at Driftpile very pyritic, both
f.g. lamellar pyrite + coarse ground pyrite + Pb-2m
around auger, in pressure shadows. Upper horizon
lower in Ba.

Section folded, faulted.

Cut off by fault (syn sed?) at south.
Continues as freshen iron to N, to SOUNDS
ground - bedded Ba + fresh.

Highest grade intersected at old Conex trench
at N end of property. Most continuity along
this horizon (barite lower here) SW ~~at~~ across
Driftpile Ch.

Chief payable gl of S of Gatoja Lbs
(KMD 1917) and N of Driftpile - no 2
drifts follow derived from west, chicken
waterward - but source - where?

Large set iron may be gl ady to a
shelf - large blocks chaotically arranged in
section above (?) bent - Ba m horizon. Upper
horizon represented by pyritic zone, no Pb m.
