Robb Corne - talk about Driftpile Nov 8/78

2 mm. horizons lower: baritic, regional extent
of lamellar spotty baritic horizon, locally 10% Zn -
some of CIRQUE baritic - Pb-Zn horizon - relict under
Kechuka thrust sheet overriden from west. Foliated,
recrystallized, partly remobilized sulphides.

upper horizon at Driftpile very pyritic, both
f.g. lamellar pyrite + coarse ground pyrite + Pb-Zn
ground argon, in pressure shadows. Upper horizon
lower in Ba.

Section folded, faulted.

Cut off by fault (syn sed?) at south.
Continues as fracture from to N, to SAINTS
ground - bedded Ba + geoch.

Highest grade intersected at old Conex trench
at N end of property. Most continuity along
this horizon (baritic lower hor.) SW ~~at~~ across
Driftpile pk.

Chert pebble gl of S of Gateja Lbs
(KAD 1978) are N of Driftpile - or 2
debris flows derived from west, thickened
westward - but source - where?

Cirque feet environ may be gl adv to a
shelf - large blocks chaotically arranged in
section above (?) baritic - Pb-Zn horizon. Upper
horizon represented by pyritic zone, no Pb-Zn.
