Dear Mr. Bonardi:

I have enclosed 4 specimens from the Erickson Creek gold mine at Cassiar B.C. for mineral identification. All specimens are from zones of carbonate-rich hydrothermal alteration of either volcanics or argillite. The enclosed chemical analyses sheets show that the alteration assemblage is rich in Ca, Mg, Fe, Si and Al. Minerals believed to be present include quartz, dolomite, siderite, calcite, mariposite; ± magnesite, talc, chlorite, epidote. I would appreciate an X-Ray diffraction mineral identification of each specimen to confirm these or other minerals.

I have a BSc. student working on the Erickson mine this summer, and he would appreciate receiving the mineralogical identification as soon as possible. My field address, after June 13 and before Aug. 31, is:
