

View looking north across the Granisle open pit. The Granisle mine produced 214 300 tonnes copper, 6 833 kg of gold and 69 753 kg silver from 52.7 million tonnes of ore between 1966 and 1982. Copper occurs within and peripheral to biotite-feldspar and quartz-biotite-feldspar porphyry intrusions of Eocene age (EBp).
