## WESTMIN RESOURCES LIMITED GAP AND BATTLE ZONE EXTENSIONS

Vancouver, B.C. (March 4, 1992) - Westmin Resources Limited announces that it has obtained assay results on the western extension of the Gap zone to section 12+01E and has visual estimates on the southerly extension of the Battle Zone on Section 15+85E.

These intersections extend the Gap Zone 61 metres to the west from Section 12+62E, and extend the Battle Zone 38 metres to the south. The Gap Zone now has a defined strike length of 201 metres plus reasonable extrapolations to over 250 metres. The Battle Zone has a defined dip length of 190 metres on Section 15+85E, plus reasonable extrapolation to over 220 metres.

The company is now drilling on the Battle zone with 3 machines.
