

WESTMIN RESOURCES LIMITED

Vancouver, B.C. (March 23, 1992) - Westmin Resources Limited announces another good drill hole intersection on the Battle Zone. Hole number 14-725, drilling on Section 16+92E and inclined -82° North, has encountered massive sulphide ore. The intersection, which extends from 271.3 to 280.6 metres, for a total core length of 9.3 metres, is visually estimated to contain 3% copper and 9% zinc. Assays should be available later this week.

The ore is about 20 metres deeper than the previous intersection on this section but appears similar in other respects.

A new hole has been started, inclined -70° South, on this section and other Battle Zone test holes are in progress on Sections 13+72E and 15+85E.
