## WESTMIN RESOURCES LIMITED BATTLE/GAP ASSAYS RECEIVED

Vancouver, B.C. (July 24, 1992) - Westmin Resources Limited announces that it has obtained assay results from two holes recently drilled in the Battle/Gap areas.

## Hole #14-730, Section 16+92E, Inclined -54° South

Hole #14-730, which apparently intersected a deeper portion of the Battle Zone, returned assays lower than visually estimated but still very good and important from the perspective of extending Battle tonnage to the South. Hole #15-462 has intersected very high grade ore which is thought to be a southern and western extension of the Gap Zone. The hole was drilled off section to the West and at the ore intersection point was 40 metres west of the section. Battle/Gap drilling continues with four machines.
