### MYRA FALLS RESERVES UP SHARPLY

Vancouver, B.C. (February 10, 1993) - Westmin Resources Limited announces that after milling 1,171,629 (diluted) tonnes of ore in 1992 at its Myra Falls Operations, proven and probable geological reserves increased from 11.2 million tonnes as of January 1, 1992 to 12.5 million tonnes of significantly higher grade ore as of January 1, 1993. The possible reserves also increased significantly from 1.7 to 2.7 million tonnes. A tabulation of comparative tonnages and grades of Myra Falls ore zones is on the attached sheet.

Detailed development drilling and access drifting related to the Battle and Gap Zones is progressing steadily and infill or extension drilling updates will be released periodically.
