



DEC 1 4 1994 WESTMIN RESOURCES LIMITED TRUMPETER EXTENSION DRILLING YIELDS A BONUS

MEMPR Vancouver, B.C. (December 2, 1994) - Westmin Resources Limited announces results from Hole No. PR112 which was drilled to provide a western stepout on the Trumpeter Zone. It has not only extended that zone 76 metres to the northwest, but has also encountered significant good grade mineralization above the Trumpeter Zone.

In addition, the silver assays on Hole No. PR111 have been corrected. The full assays on Hole No.'s PR112 and 111 as well as previous Trumpeter Zone encounters in Hole No.'s PR101 and No. PR92 are repeated for continuity.

The two mineralized zones above the Trumpeter Zone in Hole No. PR112 are fragmental zones very similar in nature to the Block 43 ore in H-W mine. Block 43 is at about the same elevation but about 1 kilometre to the southwest through untested terrain. If this upper mineralization turns out to be an extension of Block 43 it has significant tonnage implications for the eastern end of the H-W mine.

It is proposed to extend the current drilling program to test the western extensions of these intersections.
