results from agitated leach tests on samples containing nickel and cobalt. It is looking at the viability of an open pit operation and an adjacent 20,000 tonne per day whole rock leaching plant. The leach solutions will be further tested using SX-EW technology. Negotiations are being conducted between Gold City and a major mining company toward an option agreement.

17) Princeton Zeolite: I.M.P.A.C.T. Minerals Inc. has terminated an agreement with Princeton Zeolite Products to acquire the Allenby and Bromley Vale deposits.

18) Red-Chris: EAO has requested public comment on American Bullion's application by Jan. 16, 1996. The proposal is for a 50,000 tonne per day mill operation.

19) Similco: Princeton Mining Corporation reported good revenues for the third quarter; production in the fourth quarter is forecast to increase by 15%, reflecting the higher grade feed from the Ingerbelle East expansion pit.

20) Red (C-2): Teuton Resources Corp. and Minvita Enterprises Ltd. have begun drilling, primarily testing the down-dip extension of high-grade gold mineralization in Trench 4. A total of 81 trenches were confined to a core area measuring 75 by 300m. The trenches tested a 150 by 570m portion of a northwesterly trending zone containing sub-parallel shear-controlled veins and stockworks. Two distinct forms of gold-bearing mineralization are noted; the first is dominated by sulphides (S-type) and the second by hematite (H-type). The S structures prevail in the southwestern portion of the property, are linear in nature and have been traced for distances up to 330m. The H structures have been traced along strike over 190m. A potential third type of mineralization, consisting of gold-bearing mafic volcanic rocks carrying significant cobalt values, has been identified in the southeast portion of the property. Significant mag anomalies are coincident over structures. [TGS Comment: Watch for results- the hottest play in B.C. right now].

21) Shasta: Sable Resources Ltd. spent approx. \$120,000 on 4 drill holes in '95. No encouragement=no further work planned.

22) Spanish Mountain: Eastfield Resources Ltd. reports that Consolidated Logan Mines Ltd. (under an option agreement) has recently staked more ground prior to initiating drilling.

23) Specogna (Cinola): Romulus Resources Ltd., under a plan of arrangement with Misty Mountain Gold Corp., is carrying out a 8000m diamond drilling program in 57 planned holes.

24) Table Mountain: Cusac Gold Mines Ltd. reports gold production to date in 1995 is 9656 oz gold. Production is currently from the Michelle High-grade zone; driving of the 10 portal is in progress.

25) Tatsi: Golden Hemlock Explorations Ltd. has released assays from the (new) Top of the World zone, east of the Main zone, and the Big Vein showing, approx.
