- drilled 10 holes
- don't know attitude of the pipe
- up to 200m vertical
- plunging to north?
- only one attitude (dipping 75°)
- copper
- potassic alt. associated with Au
- also with sodic alteration
- harder to identify
- recognized as an alkalic  $\delta$
- in 1993
- Asper Grove Cu Camp - looking
- at low grade Au potential
- 0.2 to 0.5% Cu over 150'
- magnetic
- first gold analyses in 1990
- wonderful Cu-Au correlation
- metric or magnetic
- Au - fine or possibly
- fracture-controlled Au in
- volcanics

A1 walked top road - 1st  
- good road - right - followed  
to near major split  
- right by powerline  
- best of grades  
(PDB) cut near powerline  
on right side  
- form of close in/out  
side to east  
- to up to 0.5m over  
ground

A2 ofc above powerline - just  
above it -  
- edge of by - location  
material  
- Nitale will come in volume  
to west  
- update after  
- maybe some white

A3 west end of road  
pg - magnetic fragments with  
some material  
- alteration in a block

A9 - <sup>iron</sup> carbonate alteration
