Consolidated Pacific Bay Minerals Ltd. ("Pac Bay") is a junior gold exploration company with claim holdings in British Columbia. The company was formed and is managed by Mr. Guilford Brett, president and managing director of Cusac Gold Mines Ltd. Cusac Gold Mines is well know to the readers of this publication. Mr. Brett's mandate along with the support of the majority of the shareholders is to re-establish the Cusac mine as an ongoing producer of gold. Mr. Brett's talents as an "explorer" cannot be challenged by too many people, and it's this expertise that led to the discovery and development of the Cusac ore body. Hence, Pac Bay does the ("Looking") and Cusac does the ("Mining").

Pac Bay is well positioned in the Cariboo Gold mining camp, where some 3 to 4 million ounces of gold has been produced. International Wayside Gold Mines Ltd, under the guidance of Frank Callahan, has spent in excess of \$8,000,000 over the last few years and is now very close to a production decision. If this decision is made it will greatly enhance other miners working near by. Although Pac Bay's "Craze Creek" property is in the early stages of exploration a number of strong gold showings have been discovered and drilled. The best hole to date was CC02-01, which assayed .678oz of gold per ton over 6 feet. The company plans to complete an extensive exploration program this summer, subject to financing, which should be forth coming in the near term.
