Vanco Explorations has agreed to take over this gold prospect from Norcen Energy. The Slide Mountain claim group is situated on the Quesnel River approximately 51 kms southeast of Quesnel.

Previous exploration in the immediate area was directed to finding copper mineralization. However, Dome Exploration's announcement in April 1981 concerning a gold zone discovery containing 750,000 tons grading 0.2 oz Au per ton has renewed interest in the adjacent Slide property.


Dome's gold zone appears to lie in an area that is magnetically anomalous. Similar magnetic anomalies occur on the Slide property. Therefore, the Slide property is considered favourable prospecting ground.

A limited amount of stream sediment sampling was carried out by the current owners of the property, Canorex International Inc. Norcen personnel spent one day on the property collecting similar samples. The sample results ranged from .02 to .11 ppm Au. However, the streams sampled were worked for placer gold which renders the value of these results questionable.

The property is at the grassroots stage of exploration. The objectives for 1982 are twofold.

- (1) determine the geological environment of the magnetically anomalous areas, by mapping, prospecting, sampling and magnetometer surveying.
- (2) prospect and carry out reconnaissance mapping on the remainder of the property.

It would be supplied by helicopter from Williams Lake. The proposed program would include line cutting, geological mapping and soil sampling plus magnetic and VLF surveys.
