#### **Introduction & History**

The Foster's Bar property, a four cell tenure comprising 82.17 hectares, was staked on January 6, 2006, to investigate the potential of an old channel crossing the property. Supplementing this claim for extended coverage, the Little Foster property (tenure #551823), abutting to the south side of the Foster's Bar property, was staked by the holder hereof. Historical prospecting on the claim area is referenced in Minfile Report 7856, outlining the McGrath placer leases during November 1979. It was concluded therein, there was evidence of early Chinese presence on the east side of the Fraser, more particularly in the area comprising the extreme northwest corner of this claim. However, recovery by Chinese miners in those early years seldom was reported, and in the early 1900s they were forced off the creeks and rivers by law. Logically, further riverside placer work had been conducted on or about the claim area during the Great Depression years, yet again, no record has been found relating to production. Prospecting was also carried out by the author's field crew during the 2007-2008 fiscal, which yielded 107 grains of gold.

## **Location & Access**

The Foster's Bar claim is located along the Fraser River in the Cinquifoil Creek area, within the Kamloops Mining District. The property is centered on coordinate 121° 45' 27.3" W Longitude, 50° 31' 29.7" N Latitude, and is situate in the Fraser Valley, 34 kilometers northwest of Town of Lytton, BC or otherwise 21 kilometers southeast of the Town of Lillooet, BC. Access to the small portion of the tenure which lies on the east side of the Fraser River, is gained from BC Highway #12, north from Lytton. The bulk of the claim, which lies on the west side of the river, may be accessed from either of two directions. From the south, via crossing the Fraser by ferry at Lytton, thence following the two lane gravel road northward (toward Lillooet) for approximately 36 road kilometers, to the general area of the claim. In alternative, the claim may be accessed from the Lillooet end via the second major south-leading roadway exiting from BC Highway 99, at the southwest end of town. This road being the same as the aforementioned road on the west side of the Fraser, leading toward Lillooet from the Lytton ferry.

## **Summary & Conclusion**

Prospecting on the Foster's Bar claim during the 2007-2008 fiscal, was carried out on June 30, 2008, over the traverse indicated by red line marking on Map 2 (hereto attached). Work performed, chiefly focused on securing samples from a series of eleven shallow test pits at random points along the traverse. The depth of the hand dug pits averaged 0.75 metres, with an estimate accumulative amount of 4.2 cubic metres of material being processed. The gravels were initially classified through using a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (6mm) hand screen, then panned out to a finer concentrate using a portable re-circulating water supply. The cons were then stored in a plastic bucket and later refined by further panning. One, rough-edged 2.4 gram gold nugget was recovered, along with slightly over 23 grams of fine to flour gold.

In light of the favorable results from this fiscal program, the claim was renewed for a subsequent term.


