Have completed a preliminary report on the CANIM LAKE prospect as you requested.

Also I have talked to Dave Koop, President of Geo-Analytical Services (Western) Ltd. regarding the soil sampling problems on the prospect.


He thinks the geo-botany sampling of Jack Pine Twigs is worth a try and thinks the root systems would cover a larger area and penetrate deeper than the soil sampling method.

Their lab has been using this method for uranium and nickel. Each prospect reacts differently than others and Dave has offered to run 30 samples with no charge. It would appear that this type of sampling is about twice the cost of soil sampling. However, I suggest trying any method that has a chance to work.

I talked to Loring Lab. and Don Enders has said that your moly is very low in a sample submitted - i.e. .001%, but more information should be gained on the Molybdenite occurring on the property before conclusions are reached.

Have talked to Bill Ainsworth briefly on the 'phone before he visited the property and we will meet on his return.
