16 Km from Turnoff at Eastern Canal  
(Rover Creek Forest Service Rd.)  
(switching to Mid Slope Main Line Rd.)

Elv. - ~~245~~' 5390' @ shaft

Near cabin - dump with  
basic coarse grained ultramafic - basalt

At Shaft - dump area (30' north  
of shaft)  
30 x 10 x 5 of ore material  
& sample of shattered  
qtz vein material showing  
no sulphides of any nature -  
just dark partings - #8259  
& #8260.

Trenches to east of shaft for  
11.5 ft - strike of vein is  
255° + dip? - soft  
schistose material

Coffee Creek 800444

At 17 Km Sign:

750' further east, a 20'  
shaft just <sup>80' north of</sup> the logging road  
shows a 8" qtz vein running  
125° as vertical - Highly schistose  
material in vicinity - Sample #  
8262 random chipped from  
bulky looking str. - elev. 5240'

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BIG "M"

Lake level = 1725' (adjusted  
from 1450')

Sample # 8263 - 18 feet -  
recheck of sample # 4699.

Sample # 8264 - at mileage 73.8  
(from 72.8 at corner) (1 mile up)  
across interrupted 5 ft - main  
blasted showing in this road area -  
heavy pyrobitite, st. zone - very schistose  
(see sketch next page)
