Greetings from Tadpole Lake. Gallivanting about with a Silva GPS unit, I've obtained some coordinates for you. Please be aware that the only drill sites I was able to positively identify were the ones tagged DP 78-3 and 79-20.

Try as I might, I could find hide nor hare of DP 78-10. It seems that logging activity has obliterated any sign of a drillsite there. However I surveyed it in from DP 78-3 as best I could and feel reasonably certain that the coordinates I got are in the ballpark. As well, I found what appeared to be prepared areas corresponding to DP 78-1 & 2 as they appear on the map, but could not find any identifying tags. There were a few artefacts strewn about, but it's impossible to say whether the pigs were loggers or drillers. Anywho, here's the data:
