Dear Mike:

The following are my comments with respect to Barringer Report #258 received in today's mail.

The new geochem. data fit, and extend the currently plotted anomalous areas. However, with the exception of 30S, 14E @ 1100 Mo and 32S, 14E @ 70 Mo, the Mo results are not spectacular. Naturally ^{and} my final evaluations will hinge on the correspondence of the sludge assays pending with the geochem. data.

In contrast, however, some substantial coppers appear; these areas may warrant additional detailed sampling with follow-up drilling - where not previously tested.

A. Robertson of Barringer notes that "30S, 14E may be high in other metals, - shall we get a spec. analysis done?" You can check with Mike Wetherly and advise Robertson on this.
