Dear Miss Rasmussen:

We have made a study of the geological information that we have in our office and that covers the area of the two groups of claims in the Brenda district. We find that the 'Cathy' group is more interesting in that it is well located in respect to controlling structural trends in the area. However, the overall extent of the group is too limited to provide the required exploration opportunity in the trans verse or N. S. direction. For this reason, we opted not to make a physical examination of the ground. We suggest that your best move would be to make a deal with one of the adjoining companies; thereby adding to their acreage and exploration potential.
