

Re: Silver Star - Scranton (Feasibility) Report:
per E. Bump - W. & discussion ev. June 3/71

Main objective is show high probability that initial investment of 600,000 could be returned via portal ore blocks (as indic by B.C.) if development is concentrated within this area between 5615 - 6100 elevs. W.S. would prefer to show that return of investment possible through develop. & extraction of the above with enough add'l develop. done to prepare more western ore sections for production.

Proposals:

- Put in additional develop - production drift at elev 10-15' above present elev. 5600' level - noting that this would be entirely in vein segment west of the Sunset fault. Note Ed reports that Harry Lind & others noted that ocean road to 5700 level cut good ore which would appear to line up with the projection of the 5700 portal segment.
- Cut into base of main raise at point above 5700 level to expose actual veins above the F.W. strand followed during the last mining ops.

Require check on '5700' level elevations vs. 'Sunset 5600' sill via a local survey -

Objective in Workplan - Increase development program to provide a sufficient number of resources to maintain an economic mining operation. Although the recent 407/day (array) operation proved uneconomic it at least was very close to the reasonably close to the break-even line and demonstrated the potential profitability of an adequate develop program the property.
