The I.P. survey may be completed to-day, with a move to the Toe Group, probably by tomorrow. I have deferred the HN-WEN work until later, to try to have the Toe Group completed before too much frost and snow. This may enable the Hn -WEN work to be done ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ as well as any further detail required on the Mal-Chal., before the crew pulls out.

I have roughed a schedule of all the claims (154) that are in good standing to date. This will be typed up and a copy will be given to the Mining Recorder. They will check this schedule to their records.

Re. anomaly approx. 48S - 56S and 8W on Mal. -Chal.

This is underlain with Sedimentary types, argill. and Tuffs interbedded. There is also strong S 50 E fracturing. The dioritic phase reported exist further East. There is also a felsitic type of intrusive. Roger Caven has a specimen from 48s-8W. This could be related to the occurrence located at 250N - 1350E and ON-9E.
