108 claim group on Kleanza River, about 17 mi. east of Terrace, B.C.

Since summer of 1967 a shear zone had been traced on surface for a 2600' length, through a diff in el. of 200' avg over 20' width -  $5\% \text{ Cu}$ ;  $20\% \text{ Ag}$ .

Exam of 2 adits confirms continuity to depth.

Soil Sampling over 2000' x 3000' area indicated wide-spread mineral over the entire grid. Detailed prospecting over local 'highs' indicated  $\text{Cu-Ag}$  showings

\* { Necessary to blast off 3' of leached surf. rock.  
Several barren appearing surfaces, when opened, assays  $> 0.5\% \text{ Cu}$  across 50'

Shear zone has northerly strike. Have paralleled (H. Stube) zone at  $\pm 2500'$  to east.

1968 drilling on principal zone (zone of W.A. Tribe)

4 holes @  $-45^\circ$  over 320' strike - ~~3 to 4 lenses~~

Highest values 7' @  $4.3\% \text{ Cu}$ ;  $3.1\% \text{ Ag}$ . 3 of the 4 lenses attained mineral in the 30' range  $> 200,000$  tons in 3 lenses is indicated

Four more holes, adding length, could prove up  $> 1,000,000$  (!) tons, and with the avg grade and easy access to the sea, a profitable operation is possible.

Early March/69 - 3rd hand report - Dick states recent cut strip opened 1000' interval of mineralized material.

April 1/69 - R.A.B. reports Alvija plan  $\pm 10,000$  ft. of diamond drilling - a discovery would materially benefit area & its present measure of potential
