Dear Dick:

Dan has asked for a formal report on the Molybdenite Creek property. This would be based on my August 30, 1966 preliminary report, and expanded with whatever additional detail you and T. Kellner can provide at this time.

Dan advises that high water has prevented you people from carrying out supplementary detailed mapping. However, you might be able to provide this information quickly via copies of Keith's 1963 mapping, report (?), assays, etc.; i.e. the file that Al Anderson provided for reference during the day of the examination.

The Kit sample ran trace Ag; 0.05% Cu - confirming what was generally apparent over all but a few very small, local occurrences of good mineralization.

Actually, this Brunton survey control would be adequate for my report - preliminary planning purposes, if tied in as noted.

Please note request for tie-in of 1966 areas "A" and "B". This could be done from my station #52, located at the foot of the steep section of trail to the creek - E side of log crossing.
