On April 23, I, with Kiwan and Chris, examined the showings in the Spud claims consisting of 4 regular claim lots in the junction of CPR and Fisherman Creek ( see : Spud claim on file ). The showings were exposed by a short tunnels and pit. They consist of mainly pyrite and minor chalcopyrite with local sphalerite(?). It might be noteworthy that these showings, though thin and poor in thickness and megascopically determined grade, were associated with black argillite (please refer to : the showing skech maps).
