PROPERTY EXAMINATION RESULTS

Thomas has a massive pyrrhotite showing on which considerable trenching and excavating has been done in the past. The mineralization is almost exclusively pyrrhotite with minor chalcopyrite. Very narrow gold veins < 3 cm which occur in the southern portion of the claim group have been mined in the past on a very small scale. Sample OX-40 has been submitted for assay.

CONCLUSIONS

The area is easily accessible and is sparsely treed. A few mag. lines could delimit the zone of pyrrhotite mineralization very easily. Due to its favourable location, further examination of this property may be warranted. Thomas has two old reports on the area which he will forward to you in the near future.
