Dear Sirs:-

The Hullan mineral claim was examined on May 29th., 1915. It lies on the Phoenix-Summit Camp wagon road about two miles from Phoenix. About one half of the claim is covered with a fair growth of timber.

The rocks exposed are altered silicious limestones, overlain in part by lava.

The only development noted is a shaft about twenty feet deep and a small open cut. The shaft shows a small body of magnetite.

The following samples were taken:

Owing to the apparently small size of the ore body and the absence of gold and silver values, this claim does not justify further prospecting.
