## REPORT ON BAR-DEM GROUP

### Introduction

The Bar-Dem group was examined on Aug. 25th, 1948 while examining the Zamora group lying to the north. The writer was accompanied by Mr. Len Empey and one of the owners Mr. Nick Barlow.

### Property and ownership

The property consists of 4 claims, namely, Punky No.1 & No.2, Jan-Bar No.1 and No.2. These claims are staked immediately to the south of the Maybe claims of the Zamora group and are owned by Nick Barlow and A.J. DeMazes of Westbridge, B.C.

### Geology

As far as could be ascertained the claims lie in argillite schist and some very highly silicious schist with several small dykes. A showing of galena in an open cut is said to exist on Punky No.1 but much searching failed to locate it.

The vein system on Maybe No.1 and No.2 of the Zamora system is within a few hundred feet of the boundary between the two groups and dips towards the Bar-Dem group, but it would be very deep before entering the Bar-Dem property.

### Conclusions

At present the Bar-Dem group has no value except as a possible tunnel site for depth on the Maybe veins.
