

The map-area comprises 55 square miles in the Nicola Belt south of the Aspen Grove area (Preliminary Map No. 15). As shown overleaf, this map is included in the compilation of Preliminary Map No. 18 (scale 1 inch = 1 mile). Seven pages of notes, two tables, and two graphs accompany the map.

This map is another product of the Nicola Project of the Geological Division of the Mineral Resources Branch. A main aspect of the project is the detailed mapping of the highly varied volcanic assemblage of the Nicola Group and cogenetic plutonic rocks which are noted for the number and variety of copper showings. The stratigraphy in this map-area is significantly different from that of the Aspen Grove area and the relationship between intrusive and volcanic rocks is more evident.
