Dear Rod:

As a follow-up on our early morning conversation at the P and D, I enclose a map outlining the extent of our Mill claims on Hudson Bay Mtn. Any information that you are willing to part with on the outlined claim area would be greatly appreciated - in particular your 1"=1,000' scale geology sheets and pertinent assay data on the veins.

You also mentioned, as I imperfectly recall, that a drill hole was put down (in the late 1960's?) somewhere in the valley floor west of the Mill claims and intersected quartz porphyry. Could you provide a specific location and reference to this drill hole? You also referred to some veins in the Yorke Hardy adit which assayed in the 0.4 oz/t Au range. Any documentation you can provide of these veins (location, width, assays) would be most useful.

I look forward to your response to this barrage of questions, and hope that we can continue our conversation on your next trip west (in April for the CIM?).
