At the recent Prospectors' Convention, I met Rodney Kirkham of the Geological Survey of Canada who is very interested in nickel mineralization within the serpentinites. He feels that if the nickel occurs as a metal alloy in the serpentinites rather than as a silicate, it should be easily extractable.

He has offered to investigate samples from Federated. Would you please send half a dozen specimens from various places totalling approximately 5 pounds. I would suggest, possibly, ten lumps of rock, each weighing $\frac{1}{2}$ pound.
