Location of all samples are shown on attached map  
I would really appreciate if you send me a location of laminated alunite rich, chert-like rock you found in sept. 1990 on NW side of Treaty Glacier. Boulder of the same type of rock was also found on so called Ridge Zone (see map) in 1989. Ridge Zone is a place where in 89 shear zones with galena (running high in Ag and Au) were found. ~~They~~ <sup>They</sup> were very similar to those found on new showings in 1990.

I was trained in my country as a petrographer and also worked in this profession a few years. In order not to forget what I learned I have bought a polarizing microscope. So I would be very grateful if you send me some unwanted thin and polished sections.
