1987 Drill Hole 19	23 samples	over 341 ft
1987 Drill Hole 15	24 samples	over 99 – 238 ft
1987 Drill Hole 6	40 samples	over 351 ft

Don Harris has already been examining these cores but it would be very helpful to have your assay logs for them so that we know which pieces to concentrate on.

As I told you when I gave you the B & W SEM images of gold on pyrite etc., it takes about 6 weeks using cold hydrofluoric acid to make the mineral separates from silicate rocks. Of course if you have any new data or core that you think we should have a look at please send it along also. We will be taking lots of photos and might even return your gold!
