Dear Fred & Barry,

I think that I have discovered a significant new barite-quartz (pyrite, tetrahedrite) vein system on the north side of Brucejack Lake ("North Brucejack") and a significant unexplored copper zone north of Sulphurets Lake. Don Harris has probed the tetrahedrite north of Brucejack Lake and has found that it contains 5-7 wt.% Ag, which is slightly lower than the Shore Zones. This new vein system is very similar to the Shore Zones and appears to be quite extensive.

I am waiting for some analyses & then I will send a more complete report on these new locations.
