Dear Dr. Kirkham:

This letter is to tell you about our work in the Iskut-Sulphurets Gold Belt this coming summer, under the direction of Dani Alldrick. The purpose of this project is to map the geology and mineral deposits of this emerging gold camp in order to assist mineral exploration programmes now underway. Last year we commenced mapping the Sulphurets sheet, early results of which have been released as Open File Map 1988-4. This year we expect to complete that sheet and extend mapping into the Unuk River valley covering the area shown on the enclosed map. Field work will begin in early July and end by late September. Preliminary results will be released as an Open File 1:50 000 scale map in February 1989.

In order to get the most out of the short field season and to provide a useful product to the mining community, we invite your comments. We hope to visit as many mineral properties as possible. It would make our visits mutually beneficial if we could time them to coincide with field crews you may have working on your ground. Any information you could give us in this regard would be very helpful, and of course, would be kept confidential.
