SUBJECT: Prospecting progress by P. Risby in Powell River area.

Risby has made two phone calls to report progress since beginning work in the Powell River area.

He has nearly completed inspection of the King Billiken group and, has found no significant results. He reported on a new property 2 miles south of the K.B. group which is now being worked by Bob Micheals - the prospecter who optioned the property to Noranda which is now being drilled. The new property is a 70 feet wide porphyry "dyke" with 2-3% Cu and 1% Mo which strikes north-south and heads for the K.B. group. Risby is continuing prospecting in this area.

In addition he was taken to a "very large" copper-moly showing by a Mr. Herb Thompson of Powell River. Risby is now prospecting this area and seemed very keen of it saying that "globs of malachite are all over the place".

SUBJECT: Risby Progress in Powell River Area

Risby recently reported the following:

DATE:

March 9, 1967.

- (1)The "very large" copper-moly prospect of Mr. Herb Thompson's mentioned in memo of Feb. 23 turned out to consist of 3 veins of maximum width 18 inches from which large area of Cu stain emanated.
- Mr. Thompson accompanied Risby to another of his (2) groups. This one consists of 16 claims lying 3 miles south of the Bob Michaels' property mentioned earlier - this property, Michaels', and the King Billiken apparently lie on strike. The property consists of a 15 - 20 foot exposure of what Risby calls a 10 foot wide porphyry dyke intruding massive granite. Contains fracture fillings of Cu, Ag, Mo. One assay reported as 3.5% Cu, 1.5 oz. Ag. He recommended an examination.
- (3) Bob Michaels has evidently not made a deal on his prophyry dyke (70 feet wide with 2 - 3% Cu and 1% Mo) and I recommended that Risby express our interest in his property and attempt to arrange a meeting with Tim Sadlier-Brown who will be going up March 12.
- (4)Nothing new has been found on the King Billiken group. Tim will give Risby statement regarding property this week.
- Risby was informed of E. O. Chisholm's recommendation (5) that he find out whatever possible about Noranda's drilling venture.

(6) Tim plans to make an appraisal of Thompson's 16 claim group, inspect Michaels group, meet with Michaels, make decision re King Billiken group, and direct Risby in further prospecting.
