Page 2 of the attached report describes the ACE and ELLA group of 42 claims owned by a Powell River prospector, Herb Thompson. They cover a showing of copper with some molybdenum exposed in one small trench in a heavily forested but shallow overburden area. Thompson has had the showing several years but has done no work other than the trenches mentioned by Brown. Falconbridge have recently staked and optioned a 150-claim group with similar showings on the same batholith 3 miles away and are cutting lines for a geophysical survey.

Brown thinks the mineralization and setting are interesting enough to follow up with a geophysical test over the showing consisting of mag and Ronka EM. The specimens are slightly magnetic.

I have arranged a free examining option with Thomson on the attached terms and Boeteng and Risby will carry out a limited mag EM survey in the next few days over the immediate vicinity of the showing. It will be necessary to have Thomson sign the examining option before proceeding.

Further to my memo on this subject, Herb Thompson telephoned and said he was willing to give us more time to carry out preliminary mag survey of his ground and easier terms. He wished me to submit a new proposal regarding this. Risby informs me that he has found more copper mineralization that may be continuous with the main trenching some 700 feet away. I would recommend that we reconsider exploration of this property and have Boateng and Risby make a preliminary mag survey of the claims encompassing the showing. Prior to this I will draft up a new proposal for Thompson.

## MEMORANDUM

FROM: E. O. Chisholm

Further to my memorandum attached on the Thompson ACE group at Powell River, I yesterday made an examination of this property and would agree in general with Brown's conclusions that more work is warranted. This is based mainly on further examination made of the Falconbridge property which occurs in an almost identical geological situation some six miles to the north on the same batholith. Here a very good molybdenum copper occurrence is exposed over an area 150 ft. by 50 ft. on a 400-claim group recently staked by Falconbridge. They are proceeding with a large-scale IP survey of the area and, in my opinion, may wind up with a viable moly copper situation very favorably located near seaboard. With this in mind, we should attempt to extend the Thompson showing in size by a limited amount of Winkie drilling on the outcrop. It is well situated for this type of work, being a bedrock exposure within a few feet of a running creek. If the exposure can be extended to, say, 100 feet in either direction by drilling we can then consider carrying out an IP program in the area.

I have submitted the following tentative option terms to Thompson for his consideration and reply today:

1. Free examination period between April 20 and May 20 dates.
  2. A down payment of \$2500 May 15, 1967.
  3. Cash payment of \$5000 August 1, 1967.
  4. Cash payment of \$17,500 January 1, 1968.
  5. Cash payment of \$25,000 January 1, 1969.
  6. Cash payment of \$100,000 January 1, 1971.
- Plus a total of 200,000 shares in a 3-million share company to be formed by January 1, 1972.

The claims involved in the option are the ACE and ELIA claim group on the attached sketch, totalling 42 claims. If possible, the King Billiken and CAL and CAN groups, totalling an additional 24 claims, should be included. I believe they also belong to Thompson.

Boeteng and Risby are at present on the property doing a limited magnetic check over the showing, although it is doubtful from the tests carried out by me yesterday if magnetometer survey will be effective. IP survey would appear to be the only effective method of detecting the mineralization.

If Thompson agrees to my proposal it will be necessary to obtain the services of a packsack driller under contract to put in the initial holes immediately.

Re: POWELL RIVER DRILLING

An inspection of the drill site was made on Thursday but, due to mechanical difficulties with the drill, progress has been slow to date. Required parts and accessories were shipped Saturday from Vancouver and drilling should proceed today. Boateng is in charge of the job and has completed mag and EM survey over the claims containing the showing. He is forwarding a map today. The centre lines of the ACE and ELLA groups were tied in by tape and compass survey to ascertain their exact location. The recorded location is several miles out. The attached map shows in red the approximate location of the ACE group compared with the staked location.

R. E. Thomson, the owner of the claims, was interviewed and has offered adjoining claims to the ELLA group called the King Billiken. However, I told him that we could not be interested until the outcome of the present work is known.

MESSAGE Four holes have so far been drilled on the original showing of the Ace group. #1 hole was drilled at  $-45^\circ$  on bearing of  $200^\circ$  and stopped at 25'.

#2 hole - Vertical to depth of 75'!

#3 hole - Abandoned due to casing problem at 10' - Bg. of N.  $30^\circ$  E <sup>at</sup> ~~E~~

#4 hole - ~~depth of~~  $-50^\circ$ ,  
Drilled to 25' at  $-30^\circ$  on bg. of N.  $30^\circ$  E.

The next set up will be at 11E, 2N+4'N to test the mag anomaly. This was chosen as the first <sup>SIGNED</sup> hole on the anomaly because

REPLY of the very rusty soil found & also small amounts of chalc. suggested and pyrite when ~~exposed~~ bedrock was exposed. The minimum depth should be 100' and final depth should depend on drill results. 10E, 2N has been exposed to bedrock with little or no rust. This <sup>could</sup> possibly be the next location depending on results from 11E, 2N+4'N

The four holes drilled so far contain very little mineralization with chalc. occurring in hair line fractures, mostly in #4 hole. It looks almost certain that the main showing is just a <sup>small</sup> sheared ~~zone~~ zone with erratic mineralization. A compass survey of the main showing drill site will be sent as soon as possible.

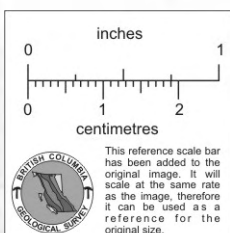
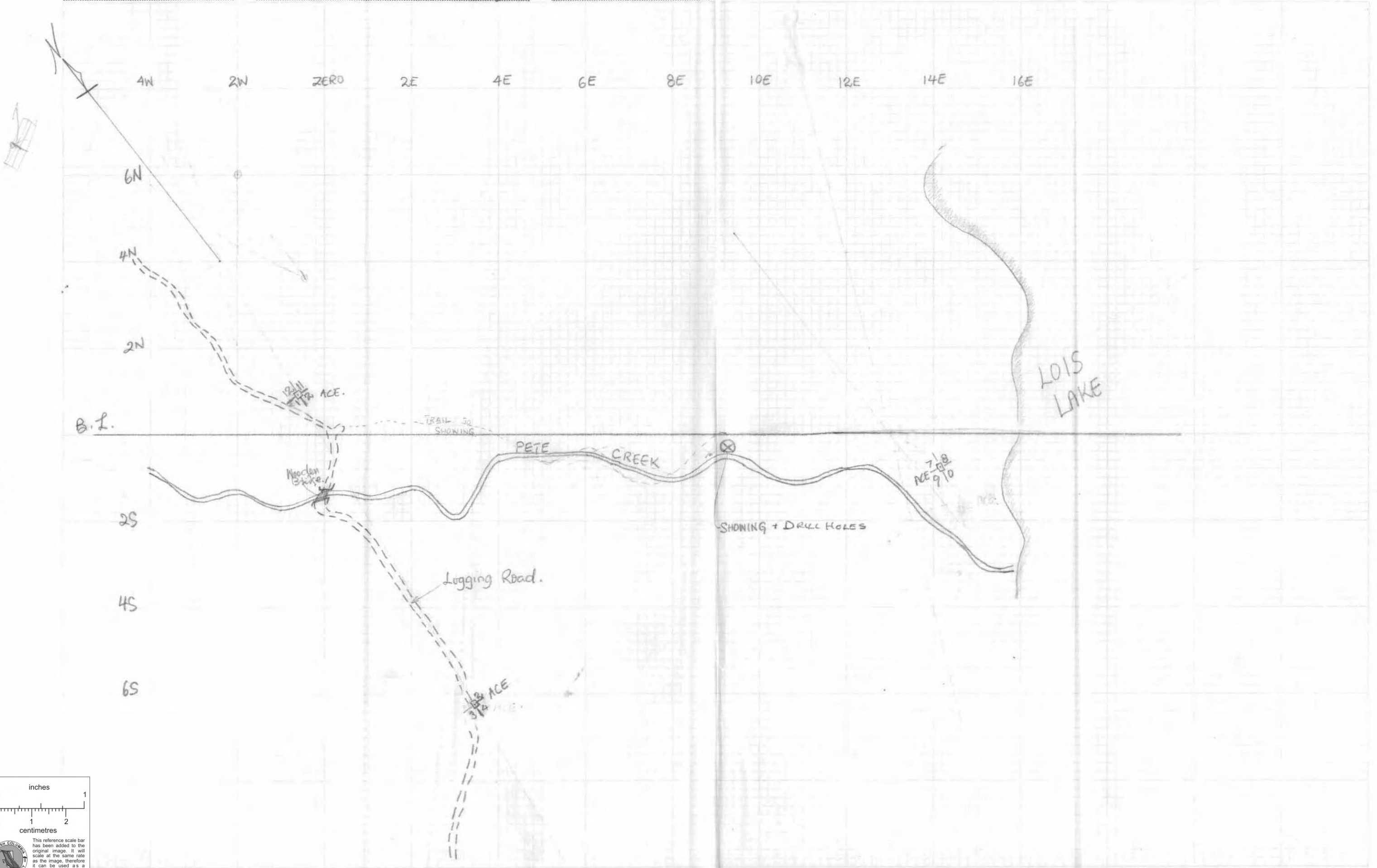

BY J. N. B. DATE April 67 SUBJECT ACE GP MAG SURVEY

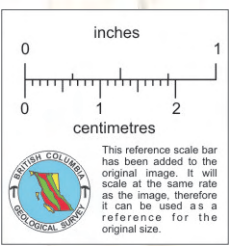
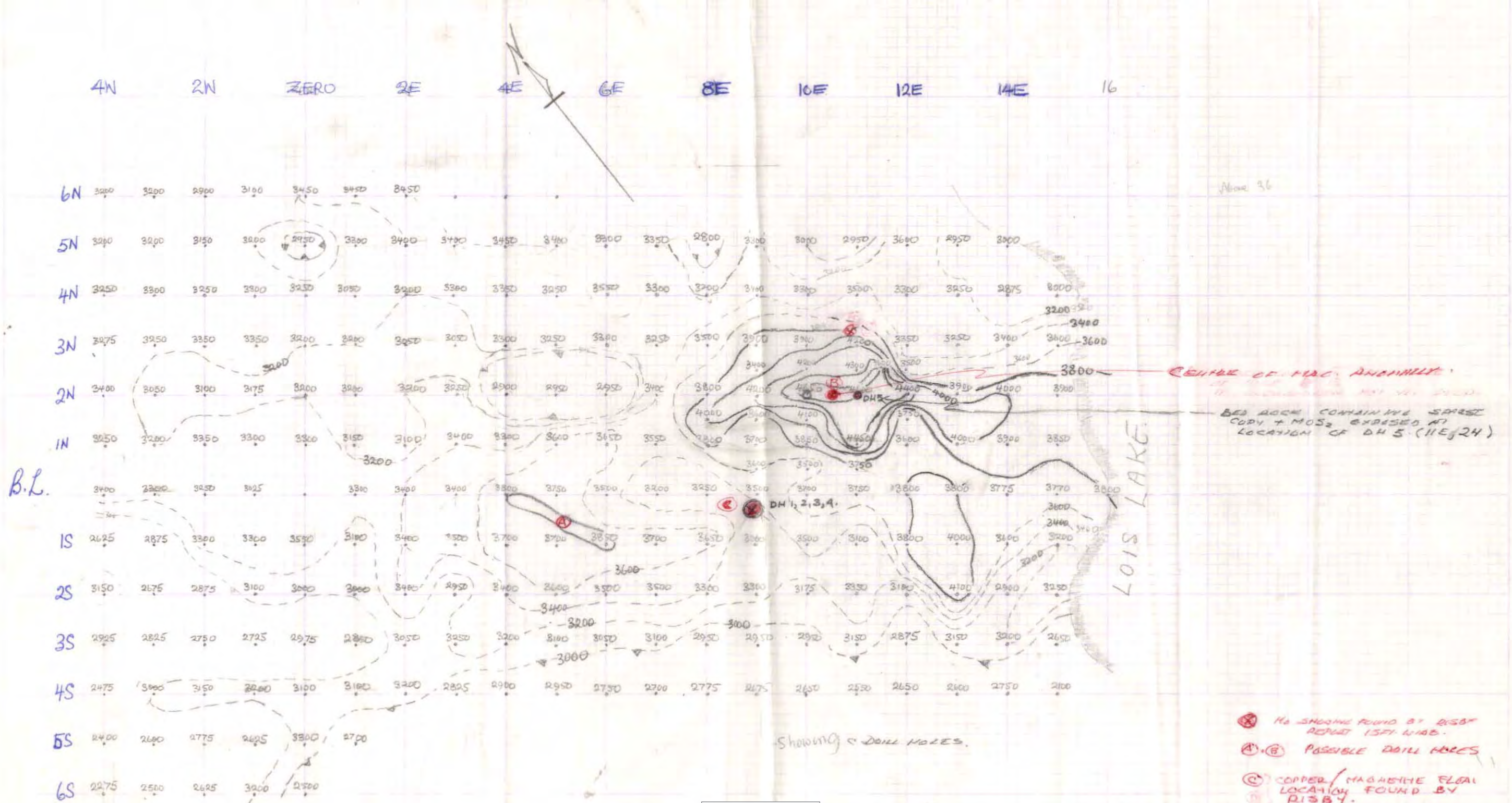
