From a brief inspection of his data, it appears there may be a couple of zones of interest which would warrant a closer look. I have requested a copy of the report and maps for further study.

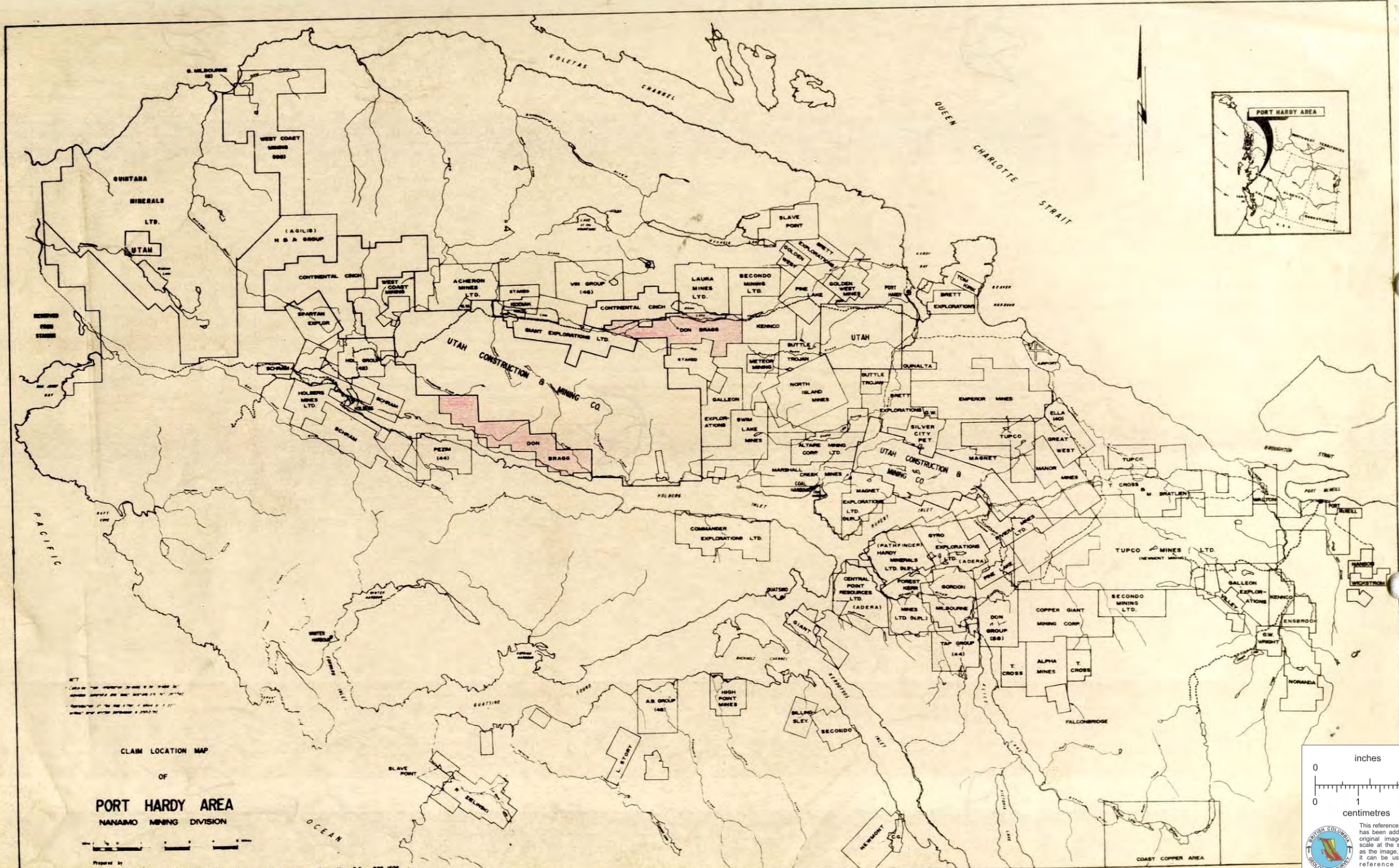

The two subject Claim Groups are indicated on the attached map of the Port Hardy Area.



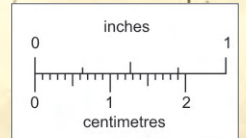
