DESCRIPTION:

Property is underlain by dark green, probably andesitic volcanic rocks of the Nicola Group (Upper Triassic). The showings on the John-X consist of disseminated to nearly massive pyrite and chalcopyrite within a prominant fault zone cutting the volcanics. The shear zone and mineralization has been exposed in two cut trenches about 1000 ft apart. Several other trenches in the immediate vicinity either have caved or failed to expose

mineralization. The best mineralized width we saw was 3 to 4 feet.

CONCLUSIONS:

Showings like this one are very common in the Nicola Group rocks, and probably occur as a result of remobilization of copper from the copper rich volcanics into zones of shearing or brecciation. There is no evidence that the mineralization on the John-X is of a more significant type, for example of porphyry copper or massive sulphide affiliation.

The property is therefore of little interest and we recommend that it should not be optioned.
