Enclosed are a number of maps and other information which you may find useful in preparing your proposal for terrain and soils work at our Tulameen Coal Project.

The investigations which you suggest in your proposal should result in a report which will fulfill some or all of the following functions:

1. Identify basic terrain and soil features at some suitable scale (1:10,000? 1:20,000?).
2. Qualitatively assess the tailing pond area for permeability and general suitability.
3. Determine areas of soils (if any) which may be worth stock-piling for future use in reclamation.
4. Assess characteristics of waste rock material important for plant growth to determine what problems may be encountered in revegetation of waste dumps.

Your proposal hopefully will take into account the small scale of this project and the limited areas of land use which are involved.

I look forward to receiving your proposal on this project and will keep you informed of progress on our Gataga Project at Williston Lake.
