Doug Leighton telephoned from Merritt, 3.00 p.m., June 23rd to say that drill hole #2 was down 260 ft. and encountering grano diorite and quartz diorite. The rock contained chloride alteration and some felspar attration but no visible sulphides. Three shifts are now working on the drill. The target area as indicated by the IP survey is from 290' - 400'. The drill crew expects to stop for a week from June 26th to July 3rd. Leighton will remain in Merritt to stake an adjusters's group area.

Bralorne-Pioneer have set up a drill just north of the Aberdeen mine in the Broom Creek area, down the valley from the Strike claims.
