Also could we have at least two copies of your report three would be better cause I think the Mining Recorder needs one for their files maybe two, you know more about it than I do.

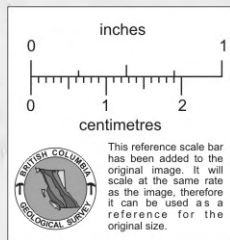
Enclosed is a sketch of where the soils were taken on the road. Tom had the only map we made showing the road and soils with relation to the claims so this sketch is only approximate.
